I am freed from a conscience defiled by guilt (Hebrews 10:22)

I am cleansed (1 John 1:7)

I am healed (1 Peter 2:24)

I am raised to life (Ephesians 2:5)

I am free (Galatians 5:1)

I am protected from judgment (1 Corinthians 5:7)

I am God's friend (Romans 5:11)

I am no longer under the curse of the law (Galatians 3:13)

I am no longer excluded from covenant citizenship (Ephesians 2:12-13)

I am no longer condemned (Romans 8:1)

The final act of atonement has been made on my behalf (Hebrews 10:10)

I can participate in the sweet communion of remembrance (Luke 22:20)

I can proclaim total victory (Revelation 12:11)

I have been separated from the world and declared holy (1 Cor. 6:11)

I have saved by grace as a gift from God (Romans 6:23)

I have been justified (as though I had never sinned) (Romans 3:25)

I have moved from darkness into the Kingdom of God (Colossians 1:13)
